




Creation – Day 1 (Light and Dark) Genesis 1:1-5

Verse: Genesis 1:1-5




Creation – Day 2 (Sky and Clouds) Genesis 1:6-8

Verse: Genesis 1:6-8




Creation – Day 3 (Land, Seas, and Plants) Genesis 1:9-13



Verse: Genesis 1:14-19




Creation – Day 5 (Birds and Fish) Genesis 1:20-23

Verse: Genesis 1:24-31




Adam and Eve in the Garden Genesis 2:8-25




Tower of Babel Genesis 11:1-9




Abraham and Isaac Genesis 22:1–19


David and Goliath Verse: 1 Samuel 17:1-50


Solomon Asks for Wisdom Verse: 1 Kings 3:3–14




Naaman is Healed Verse: 2 Kings 5:1–14




Esther Becomes Queen Verse: Esther 2–7




Esther Saves Her People Verse: Esther 7–8




Jesus Heals a Blind Man Verse: John 9:1–12




The Good Samaritan Luke 10:25–37

Verse: Luke 15:1-7




The Prodigal Son Luke 15:11–32

Verse: Luke 15:11-32




Jesus Dies on the Cross Matthew 27:32–56
